How do children join the Good News Club®?

Child Evangelism Fellowship will not allow any child to attend *Good News Club*® unless we have a signed permission slip from the child's parent/guardian. The parents can then review the information about *Good News Club*® and determine whether they want their child to participate. Parents are always welcome to attend club.
